3 Maximum Annual Water Extraction Limit

The Water Allocation Plan requires that a Water Resource Works Approval nominate a “maximum annual water extraction limit” in relation to the wells listed on the approval. If the wells are co-located a single maximum annual water extraction limit can apply to all wells. If the wells are significantly distanced from one another, multiple water resource works approvals may be required to be issued, each with a single maximum annual water extraction limit.

This limit should be the maximum volume of water which is intended to be extracted from the wells listed on the approval, and is the volume which should have been used to provide evidence in relation to section 7.4 of the Water Allocation Plan to demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Minister that no adverse impacts will occur due to the taking of this volume from the specified location.
